Application for Submitting Intrastat Declarations
User Guide

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1 Introduction

To collect Intrastat data, the Ministry of Finance – General Directorate of Customs, in cooperation with the Czech Statistical Office, developed the InstatEvo application. Starting in 2026, InstatEvo is intended to become the sole application for submitting Intrastat declarations (replacing InstatDesk and InstatOnline) and will meet the needs of all clients. The application is provided free of charge.

Data intended for transmission can either be entered manually or imported into InstatEvo from other programs, provided that the format defined by the Customs Administration is adhered to. The required format is CSV (Comma Separated Values) and is published on the website of the Customs Administration. There is no longer a limitation on the number of imported records.

InstatEvo includes functionalities for verifying the correctness of data during input as well as validating submitted data on the server. It is very important to carefully follow the process of submitting both new and corrected data, and subsequently verify their receipt and correctness.

To assist users with working in the application and to provide technical support, the General Directorate of Customs has established the Intrastat Helpdesk located in Olomouc. The Helpdesk is available on working days from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at +420 261 331 997, and during data collection periods outside of working hours at +420 725 101 542. Inquiries can also be sent to the email address

intrastat@cs.mfcr.cz. Up-to-date information on technical issues is available on the Customs Administration Portal (PCS) under the main menu "Other competences" and submenu "Intrastat". Methodological questions can be directed to the Czech Statistical Office website.

The aim of this user documentation is to assist you with the installation and use of the InstatEvo application.

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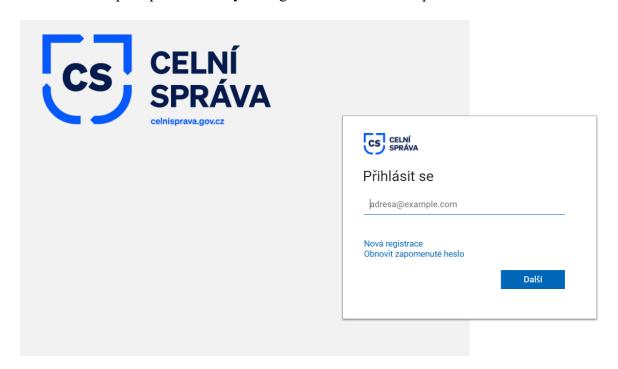
2 Technical Specification

InstatEvo is a web-based multi-user application, requiring only an up-to-date web browser.

The application has been tested in Edge, Chrome, and Firefox browsers.

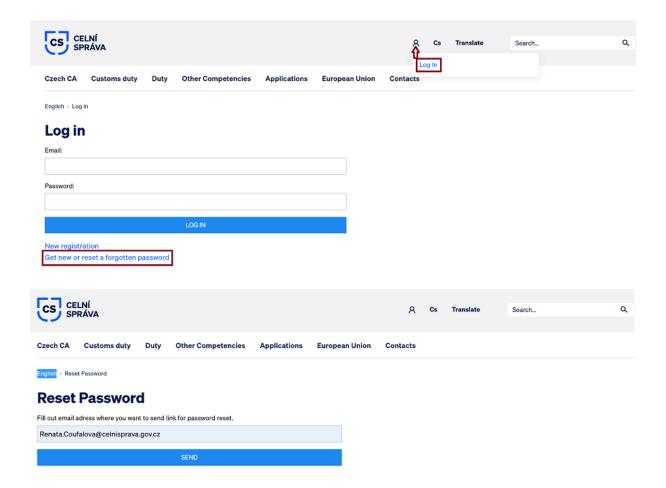
3 Login

It is not possible to log into the application without prior registration as described in Section 4. You will be prompted to enter your login email address and password.



In this form, you can also select "New Registration" to register a new account. Such an account must then be authorized for access to the application by submitting a request to the customs office as described in Section 4.

If you are logging in for the first time or are unsure whether you are entering the correct password, you can use the "Retrieve or Reset Forgotten Password" function.



A link to reset your password will be sent to the provided email address; clicking on it will open a dialog for changing the password.

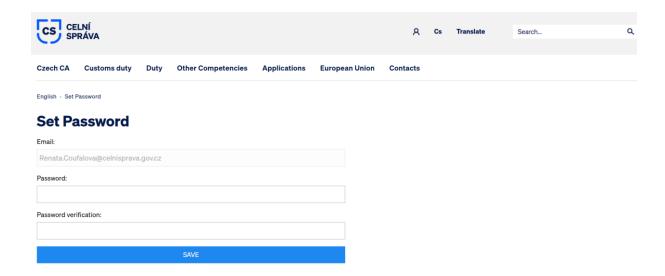

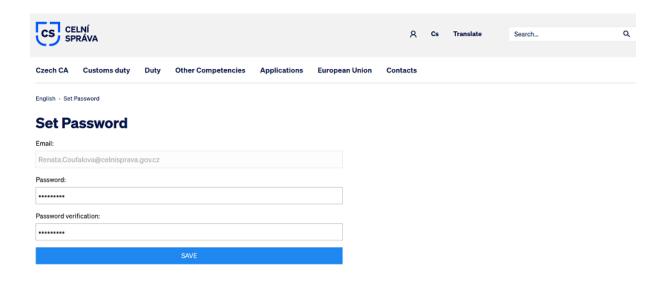

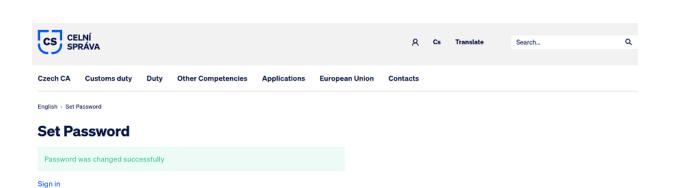

4 Registration

Registration is a basic requirement for authentication and authorization to submit declarations.

It involves submitting a specified form to the customs office via a dataBox More information about the registration process can be found here.

5 Entry of Report Items

5.1 Rules for manual entry

In the "New Report Item" menu, by clicking on "Manual", you will access the form for manually entering individual Intrastat declarations. Each field must be completed in accordance with the applicable legal regulations for the relevant reporting period, as published by the Czech Statistical Office (CZSO). These documents can be downloaded from the CZSO website (www.czso.cz).

The application contains built-in code lists also published by the CZSO, but they are also available on the website of the Customs Administration, under the "Applications" -> "Code Lists" menu, in the "Intrastat" section.

A description of the individual fields and control elements follows. Fields that serve only for selecting a value from a code list or for simple value entry will not be described, as the method of completing them is defined by legal regulations.

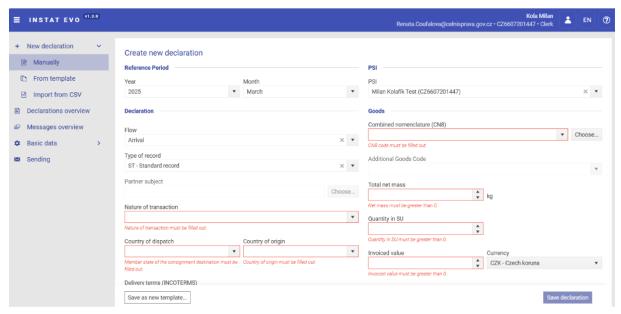


Figure. New declaration.

5.2 Reference Period

Enter the period for which the declaration is being completed. By default, the system offers the previous month as the reference period, as this is the most common case. However, you may also wish to submit a declaration for the current month or any previous month as a supplementary report. Pay close attention when selecting the reference period — submitting a declaration for the wrong period is a common error!

5.3 Selection of PSI

Select the reporting PSI. If you are submitting declarations only on behalf of your own entity, the field is automatically filled in. If you submit on behalf of multiple reporting units, the field will be empty and you must choose from the available units. If no reporting unit is selected, the "Save Report Item" button will not be available!

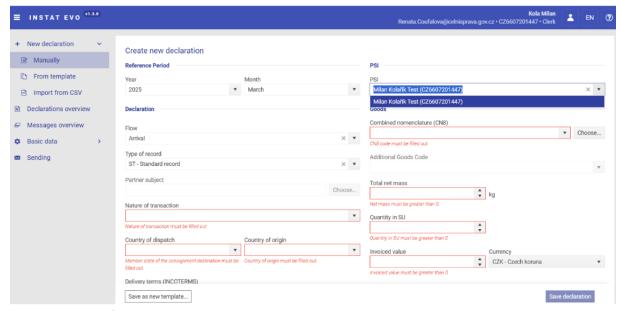


Figure. Selection of PSI.

Type of Record

Enter "ST" for a standard declaration, which is the most common case. Another frequently used code is "NN" for a negative declaration. This code is used when the reporting unit is required to report but did not conduct any trade during the given month.

When this code is entered, the system generates a negative declaration that includes only the year, month, direction (whether it is a negative declaration for arrival or dispatch), and the reporting unit submitting the negative report.

Other codes are less common; the rules for their use can be found in the relevant legal regulations.

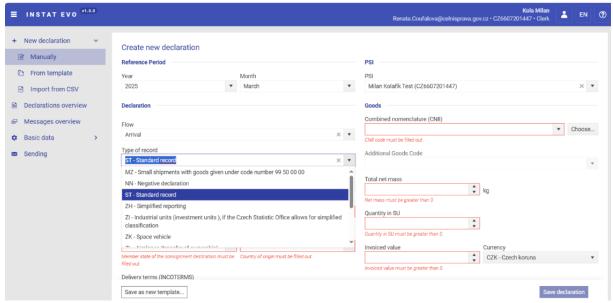


Figure. Selection of declaration item type.

5.4 Combined nomenclature and additional goods code.

Allows the selection of an 8-digit commodity goods code based on the code list provided by the Czech Statistical Office (CZSO). In the search field, you can enter either text (a substring will be searched) or a number (searched from the beginning). For example, entering "38" will find all numbers starting with 38; entering "naft" will find biodiesel. If a statistical code is required, you will be alerted in this field by a red notice and the option to select it will be enabled (the statistical code is an additional goods specification required for certain items by the Ministry of Industry and Trade). Alternatively, the "Select" button with similar functionality can be used.

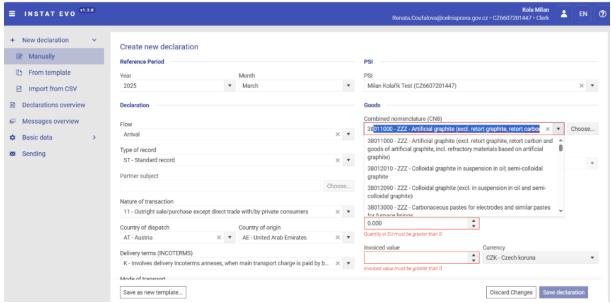


Figure. Selection of CN8 code.

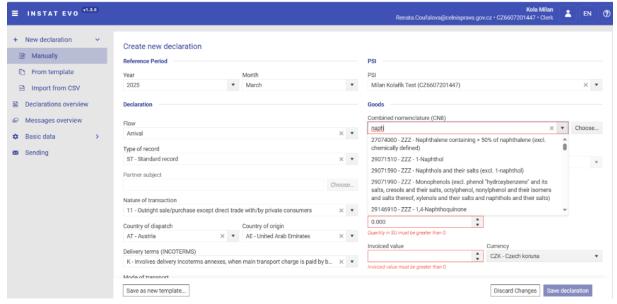


Figure. Selection by name.

If the exported or imported goods reported in Intrastat are identified by one of the Combined Nomenclature codes listed in the Communication of the Czech Statistical

Office No. 498/2021 Coll., introducing the code list of Selected Goods with Additional Statistical Codes (DOPL_KN), as amended, a specific two-digit numerical code, referred to as the "statistical code," must be added to the declaration, corresponding to the clarified name of the goods.

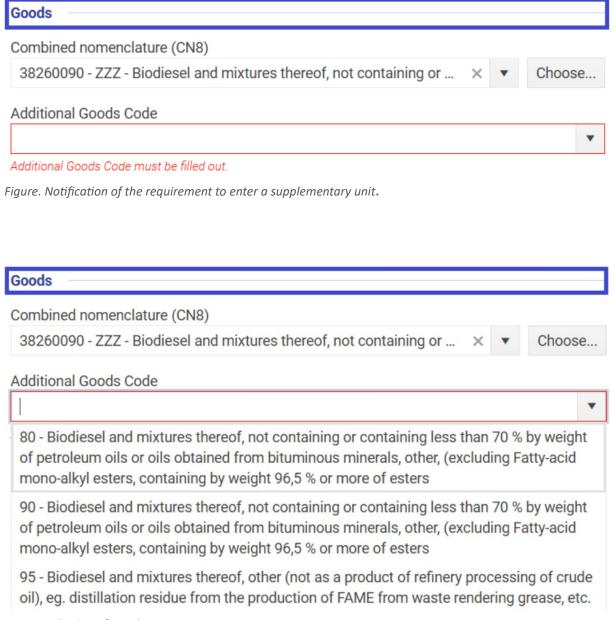


Figure. Selection of supplementary unit.

5.5 Net mass (weight)

A decimal number with three digits after the decimal point. If the weight is less than 1, the decimal number is used (e.g., 0.326); if the weight is greater than or equal to one, it is rounded to the nearest whole number and completed with zeros (e.g., 3.401).

 \rightarrow 3.000). If electricity or radioactive materials are being declared (CN8 codes starting with 2844 or 2716), the constant 0.001 must be entered.

5.6 Quantity in suplementary unit

A decimal number with three digits after the decimal point. The QSU for specific goods is firmly set in the goods tariff, see the previous section. If the unit of measure is "ZZZ", the value must always be "0.000"; in all other cases, it must be greater than "0.000" and represent the quantity in the given unit. If the quantity is a whole number, three zeros must be added after the decimal point.

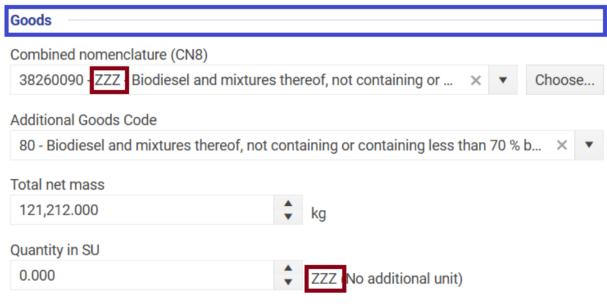


Figure. Entering quantity in supplementary unit.

5.7 Invoiced value

An integer representing the value of the goods in whole Czech crowns (CZK). If the invoice states the value in a foreign currency, it is necessary to set the foreign currency, enter the invoiced value in the foreign currency, and the exchange rate value in CZK. By default, the field available for input is "Invoiced Value" in CZK (see Fig. 1). If the value is known in a foreign currency, for example EUR, select "Foreign Currency" from the dropdown menu, enter the invoiced value in the foreign currency and the exchange rate value in CZK (see Fig. 2). The "Invoiced Value" field will then become disabled. After entering the values, press the "Recalculate" button (see Fig. 3)

and the recalculated amount will be transferred to the "Invoiced Value" field (see Fig. 4).

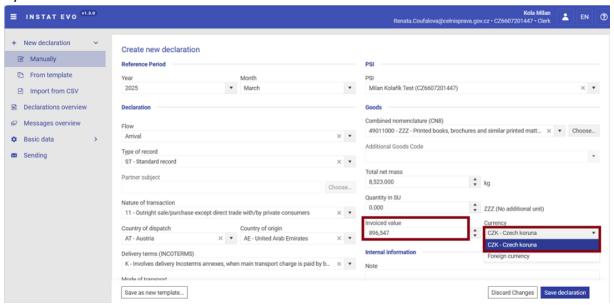


Figure. Entering the invoiced value directly in CZK.

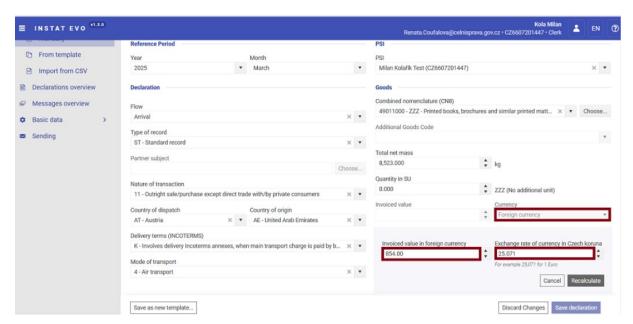


Figure. Setting a foreign currency, entering the invoiced value in the foreign currency and the exchange rate in CZK.

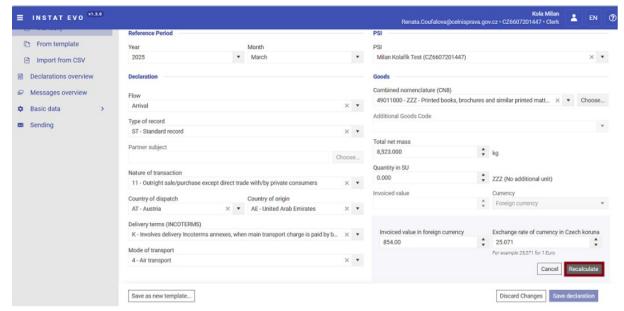


Figure. Recalculate.

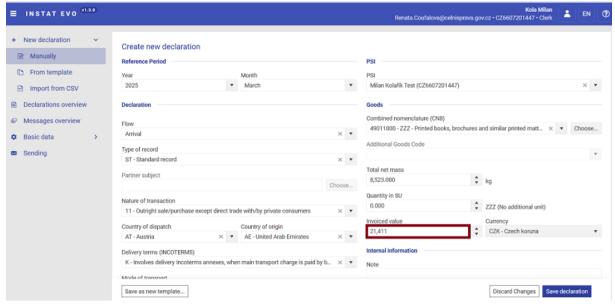


Figure. Recalculated value.

Note

A note can be added to each declaration, which will be saved. In the "Report Items Overview" menu, notes can then be filtered — a typical use case would be entering an invoice number into the note and subsequently filtering all declarations related to a single invoice.

5.8 Saving declaration item

The declaration is saved by pressing the "Save Report Item" button. If you want to save the declaration as a template, use the "Save as New Template" button (see Fig. 5) before pressing the "Save Report Item" button. The "Save Report Item" button becomes available only after all active report fields have been completed. When the button is pressed, a validation check is performed, and if everything is correct, the declaration is saved. If the declaration contains errors (see Fig. 6), you will be notified, and the errors must be corrected before saving. After the declaration is successfully saved, a dialog will appear (see Fig. 7), where you can choose to go to the "Report Items Overview" (overview of entered items), "New with Values" (create a new declaration using the values from the saved one), or "New Report Item" (create a new blank declaration).

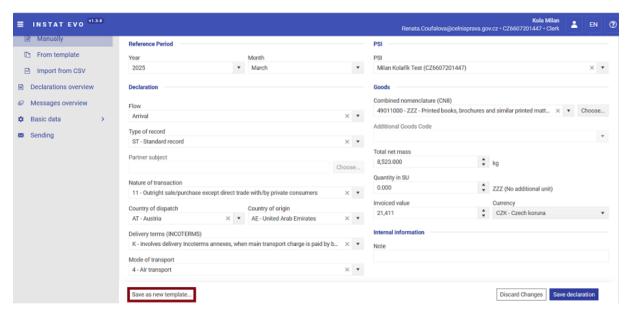


Figure. Save the declaration item as a template.

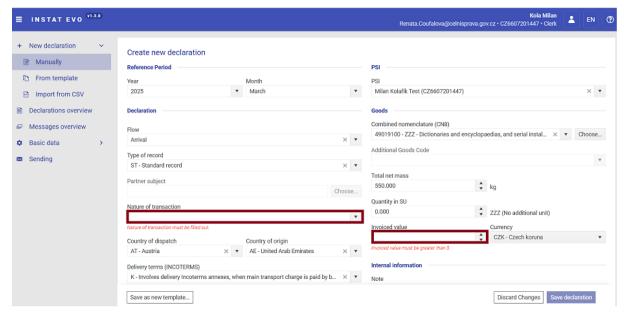


Figure. Warning about errors.

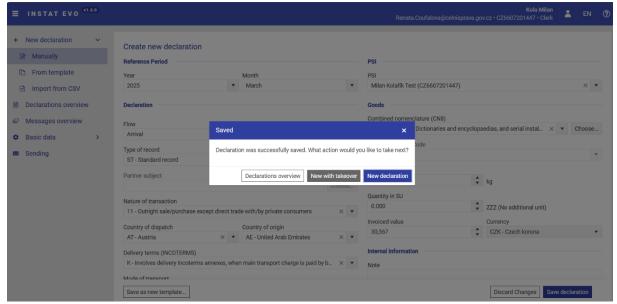


Figure. Successfully saved declaration.

6 Import of Declarations and Errors During Import

6.1 Rules for Import Declaration items

Using the functions in this menu, you can import declarations in CSV (Comma Separated Values) format from external sources, such as your accounting systems. Imported files must comply with the specified format. The file can either be a plain text file with a .csv extension or compressed in .zip (.gz, .gzip) format. You can choose any delimiter; by default, a semicolon is set.

If the net mass is less than 1 kg it is declared after the decimal point (for example: 0.432).

If the net mass is greater than 1 kg it is declared after the decimal point (for example: 0.432).

If the net mass is greater than 1 kg the value is rounded mathematically to the whole kilogrammes, (45.682 => 46.000; 45.499 => 45.000).

If we declare electricity or radioactive substances (CN8 beginning with 2844 or 2716.) we have to declare net mass 0.001 for these goods.

2. Amount in supplementary unit has to be declared with 3 decimal positions after a decimal point too.

Three decimal positions have to be declared even in situations when it is somewhat illogical for example you declare in PCE (pieces) so 12 pleces must be written as 12.000.

The same situation is with the supplementary units NEL and NPR.

If the supplementary unit is unspecified (ZZZ) the value in supplementary units must be 0.000.

3. The region of origin which was declared with dispatches is now completely removed.

6.2 Import of delaration items

In the "New Report Item" menu, by clicking on "Import from CSV," you select the file for import by pressing the "New Import" button.

The "New Import" table will appear, where you click on "Select File" (see Fig. 8). A dialog for file selection will open (see Fig. 9). Select the file and press "Open."

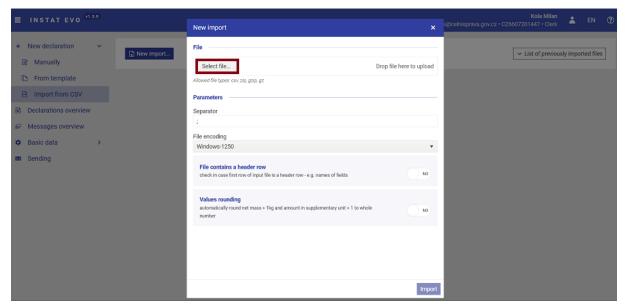


Figure. File selection.

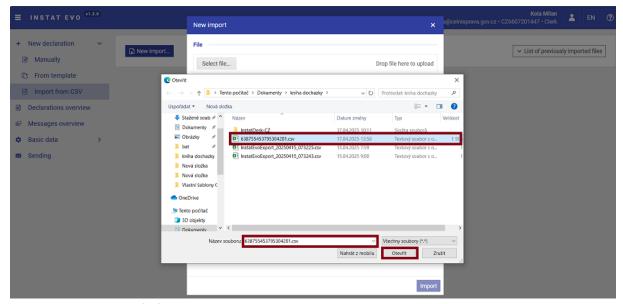
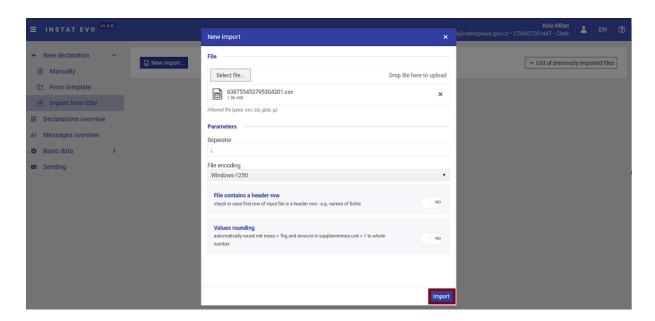


Figure. Selecting a specific file.

Once the file is selected, perform the actual import by pressing the "Import" button.



If the imported file contains no errors, a message confirming successful import will appear: "The file has been successfully imported."

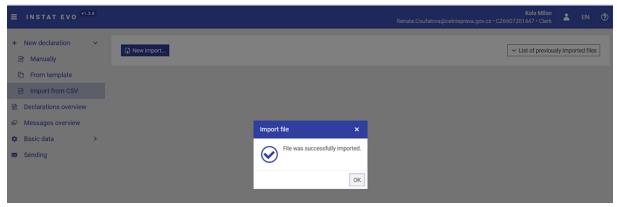


Figure. Confirmation of successful import.

6.3 Errors During Import

f the import is performed as described above and the file contains critical errors (e.g., an incorrect file type), it will be rejected. The application will not allow the acceptance of any declarations. Critical errors are highlighted in red in the information dialog. The errors must be corrected either directly in the import file or in the application from which the data was exported.

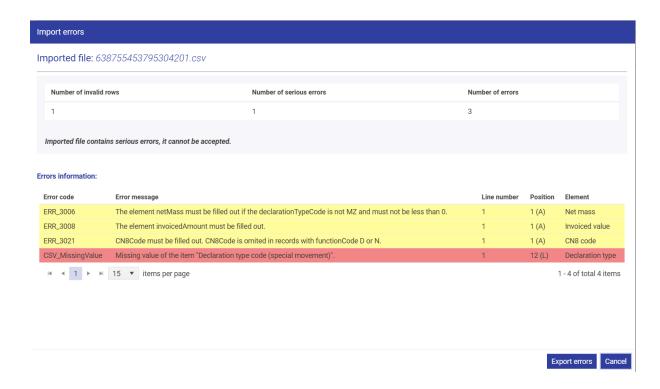


Figure. Rejected file.

If the import file is incorrect but does not contain critical errors, the user can decide whether to accept the declarations from the source or discard them. Accepted erroneous records must be corrected in the "Report Items Overview" before they can be submitted. If the errors are not corrected, the records cannot be sent to the server. A common issue is outdated code lists or incorrectly implemented validations in the accounting system — in such cases, please contact your software provider.

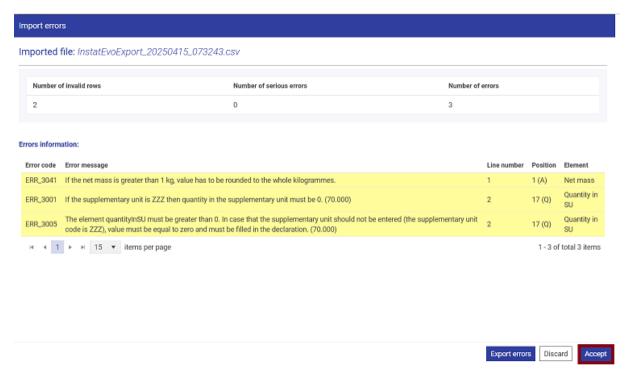


Figure. Display of adopting erroneous data.

6.4 Correction of Erroneous Items from the Import File

n the "Report Items Overview" menu, set the reporting unit, year, month, direction, record type, and status to "New with Error." Click the "Apply Filter" icon. The erroneous imported items will be displayed (see Fig. 10). Move the cursor to the edit icon on the right (see Fig. 11). The correction form will open (see Fig. 12), where you correct the values and click "Save Report Item" (see Fig. 13). Corrected items will no longer appear in the "Report Items Overview" under the status "New with Error." After correcting all items, perform the standard submission.

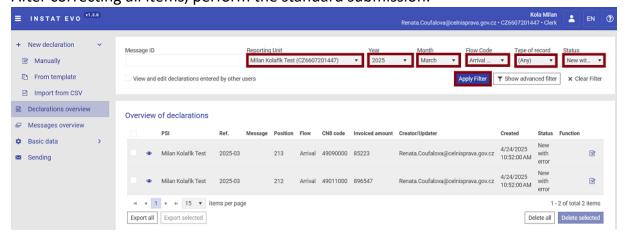


Figure. Display of erroneous import items.

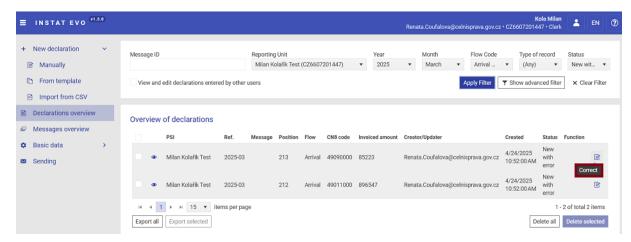


Figure. Button for editing an erroneous declaration item.

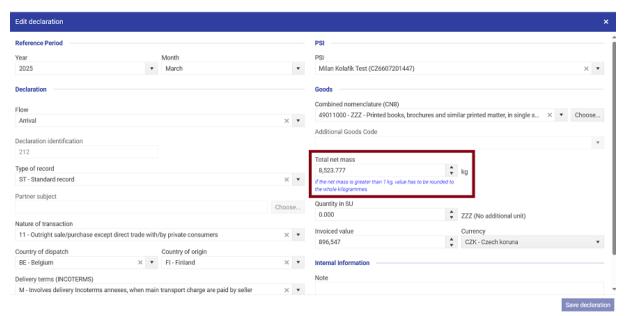


Figure. Erroneous declaration item.

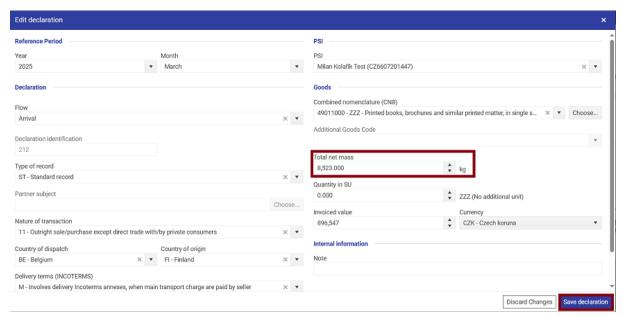


Figure. Correction of erroneous declaration item.

6.5 Deletion of Erroneous Items from the Import File

In the "Report Items Overview" menu, set the reporting unit, year, month, direction, record type, and status to "New with Error." Click the "Apply Filter" icon. The erroneous imported items will be displayed.

Deletion can be performed in two ways, both having the same effect:

Selecting the items to delete. This method is used when deleting a smaller number of declarations. Select the declarations you want to delete and click "Delete Selected" (see Fig. 14). You can also use the "Select All Displayed Report Items" button, which selects or deselects all visible declarations. The actual deletion is performed by pressing the "Delete Selected" button (see Fig. 15)

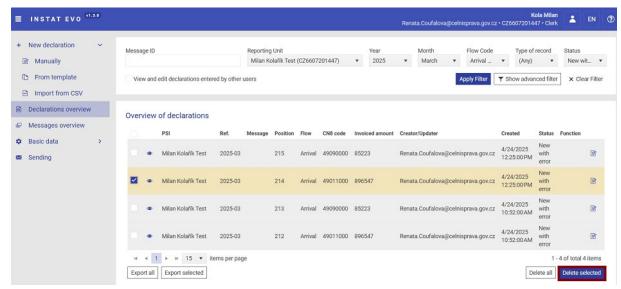


Figure. Selection of a declaration item for deletion.

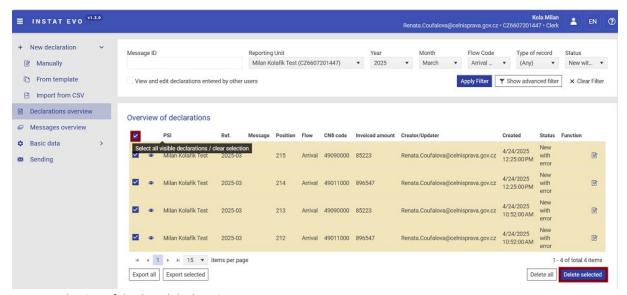


Figure. Selection of displayed declaration items.

• By filtering and using the "Delete All" button. This method is typically used when deleting a large volume of declarations. First, filter the declarations you want to delete. By pressing the "Delete All" button, all declarations that match the filter criteria across all pages will be deleted.

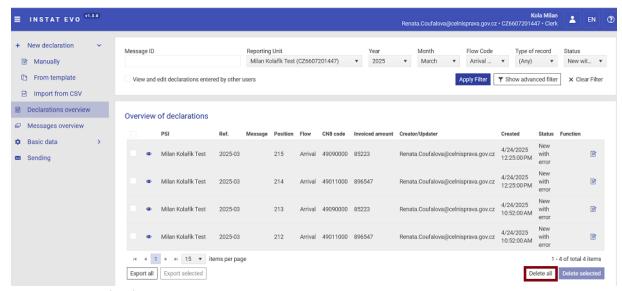


Figure. Deletion of all filtered items.

7 Use of Templates

7.1 Entry from template

When creating new declarations, you can use the application's template feature to save declarations with frequently recurring data and reload them later. The template does not contain value fields (such as unit of measure, weight, invoiced value); these fields must be filled in manually. The template is not tied to a specific reporting period, so it may happen that an older saved template contains data that is no longer valid for a newer reporting period (e.g., due to updates in the code lists). A template is created after filling in a new report item by clicking the "Save as New Template" button. This must be done before actually saving the declaration into the form.

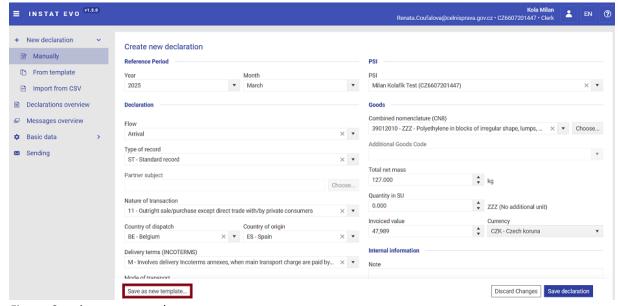


Figure. Creating a new template.

After clicking "Save as New Template," you will be prompted to name the template.

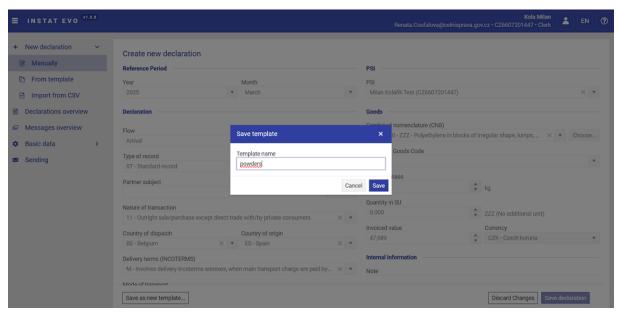


Figure. Naming the template.

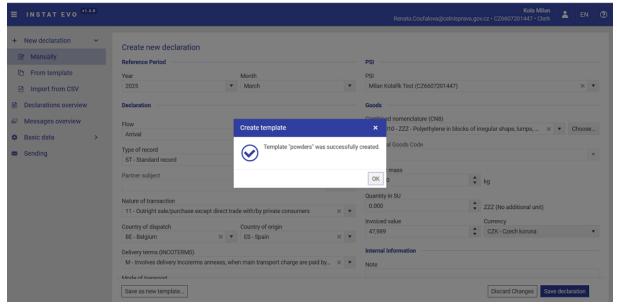


Figure. Creating the template.

7.2 Loading the template

Loading is done from the "New Report Item" menu by clicking on "From Template." Here you can select your previously saved templates with the goods description and transfer them into the current declaration by clicking "Select."

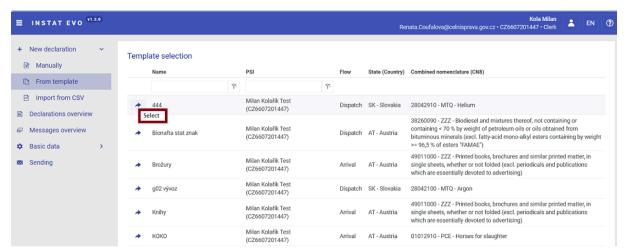


Figure. Loading the template.

8 Declaration Items Overview

In this menu, you can work with items created according to Section 5.1 or imported items. Declarations can be viewed based on the set filters, edited, or deleted, and they can also be exported to CSV format..

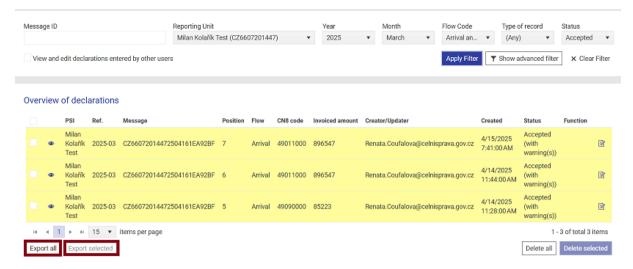
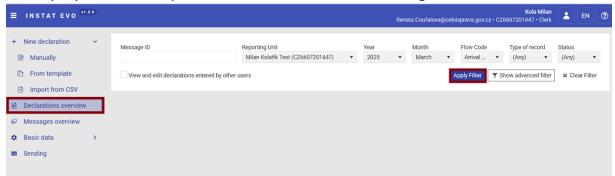


Figure. Export declaration item.

8.1 Declaration Items Filter

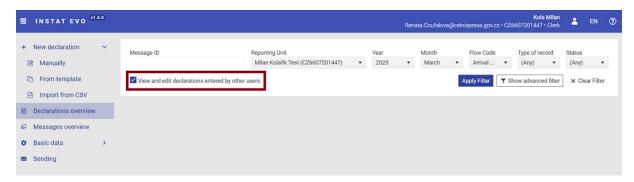
This menu opens automatically upon entering the application, but no data is selected initially. By default, the previous month is set as the filtering criterion.



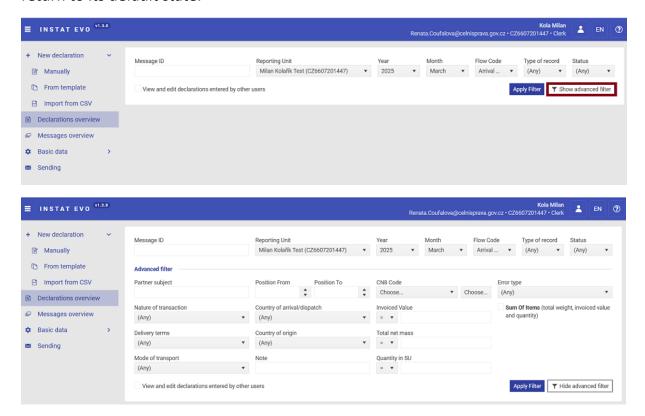
By clicking the "Apply Filter" button, you can select the relevant data. Entering multiple filter criteria narrows the selection, with all criteria applied simultaneously.

8.2 View and Edit Records Entered by Other Users

If two or more users have access to the application, by default, only the data entered by the currently logged-in user is displayed. There are situations where it is necessary to view or edit data entered by another user, for example, due to illness or an employee's departure. If you need to view or modify such data, check this option.



The "Show Advanced Filter" button allows you to display all available filter criteria. If you want to clear all filter settings, use the "Reset Filter" button, and the filter will return to its default state.



8.3 Meanings of Filter Criteria

Declaration Identifier

This is the identification number of the report in which the declaration was submitted.

Reporting Unit

Filtering by reporting units. Especially useful for senders who submit for multiple reporting units.

Period Month-Year

Filtering by the reference period of the declaration.

Direction

Filtering by the direction of goods movement.

Type of Record

Filtering by the standard or special type of goods movement.

Status

Filtering by the status in which the report item is currently located.

Partner Entity ID

Filtering by the tax identification number of the partner entity in the EU member state to which the goods are exported.

Position From-To

Filtering by the position of the report item.

Commodity Code

Filtering by the Combined Nomenclature commodity code.

Error Type

Filtering by the type of error in the report item.

Nature of Transaction Code

Filtering by the code of the commercial operation for imported or exported goods.

Country of Destination/Dispatch Code

Filtering by the country code of destination or dispatch.

Invoiced Value

Filtering by the invoiced amount, mathematical operators can be used.

Total of Items

When this field is selected, the total weight, invoiced value, and quantity of the filtered report items are displayed.

Terms of Delivery Group Code

Filtering by the code of the terms of delivery group.

Country of Origin Code

Filtering by the country where the goods were manufactured, processed, mined, grown, etc.

Net Mass

Filtering by net mass.

Mode of Transport Code

Filtering by the mode of transport most likely used when the goods crossed the borders of the Czech Republic.

Note

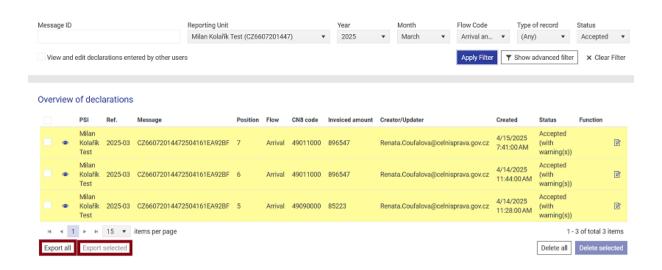
Two notes can be added to each declaration; these are stored and can be filtered. A typical use case is recording the invoice number in the note and subsequently filtering all declarations from one invoice.

Quantity in Supplementary Units

Filtering by the quantity in supplementary units, mathematical operators can be used.

Buttons "Export All" and "Export Selected"

The "Export All" button allows you to export all selected (filtered) rows to a CSV format, while the "Export Selected" button exports only the rows that have been selected by ticking a specific line (see Fig. 49). Pressing the appropriate button opens a system dialog for opening/saving the file (see Fig. 50); selecting "Open in Excel" will open the table as shown in Fig. 51. This function can be used, for example, to create your own reports or for editing and repeated importing. The values in the table are sorted according to the established order specified in the document "CSV Import File Structure," which is described in the Import section.

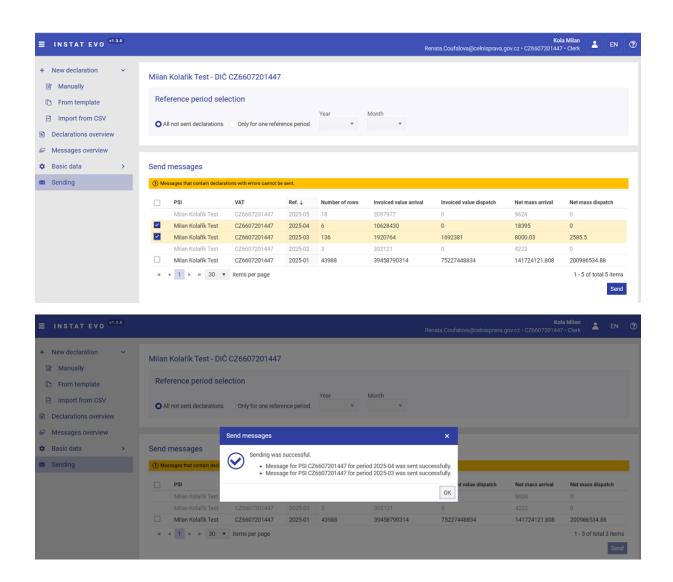


9 Submission of Declaration Items

9.1 Procedure for Submitting Declaration Items

Submission is used to create a Declaration that includes all unsubmitted Declaration items for individual reference periods and to subsequently send it to the Customs Administration server. The function for submitting data can be found under the "Submit" button. After entering the menu, you can choose whether to create Declarations for all reference periods or select just one. We recommend keeping the default option "All unsubmitted items," which will display all Declarations that have not yet been submitted.

On the left side of the row, select the Declaration you want to submit—or use the checkbox in the header to select all—and then press the "Submit" button. Confirm the submission by clicking OK.



WARNING: Declarations that contain items with errors cannot be submitted!!

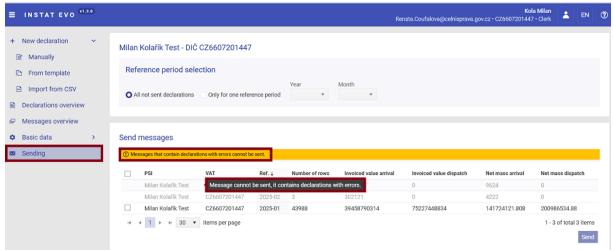


Figure. Declarations containing errors that cannot be submitted.

Important.

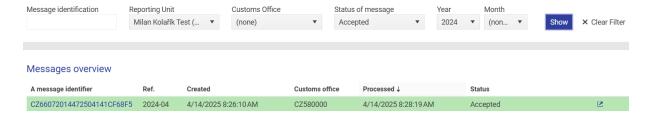
All newly created Declaration items must go through the submission process, as well as any corrections or deletions of already submitted Declaration items. For this reason, we recommend using the "All unsubmitted items" option when selecting Declarations—this will display all Declaration items that have not yet been submitted.

9.2 Declaration and Receipt Verification

The Declaration Overview is used to verify the successful submission of Declaration items. Here, you will receive a response from the processing center regarding your submission, as well as a list of any errors or warnings about potential issues.

Accepted

The Declaration is highlighted in green, and the response states: "The Declaration was successfully received by the Intrastat center." This confirms that the Declaration has been officially received by the Customs Administration server.

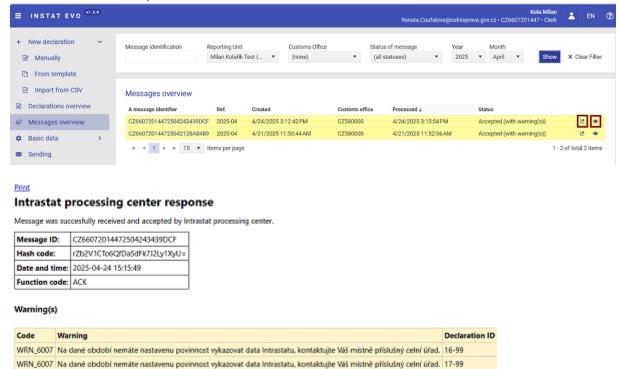

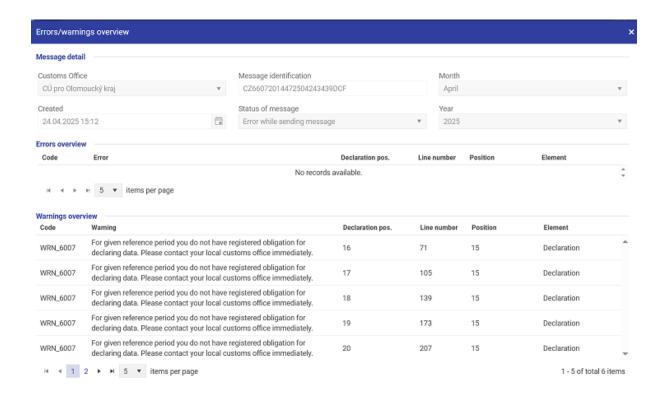
The Declaration is highlighted in yellow, and the response states: "The Declaration was successfully received by the Intrastat center," along with a list of warnings about potential errors. This confirms that the Declaration has been officially received by the Customs Administration server; however, the system detected a possible issue during validation.

In this case, it is necessary to review all warnings to determine whether they indicate an actual error or if the item is correct. If an error is found, the corresponding Declaration item must be corrected according to section 7.2. If the item is correct, no further action is required.

ou can find the marked Declaration items for review in the "Declaration Items Overview" as described in section 5.4.

The item number shown in the warning should always be used **without the suffix -99**. The "-99" suffix is intended for machine processing only.

241961-99 → Item number: 241961

Rejected

The Declaration is highlighted in red.

This is a rare state in the INSTAT EVO environment, as the application always contains up-to-date code lists used to validate data during input. An entire Declaration is rejected if even a single Declaration item is rejected. The contents of such a Declaration are not recorded by the Customs Administration, and once the issues are resolved, the Declaration can be resubmitted.

The Declaration can be deleted using the "X" symbol at the end of the row. The reason for the rejection can be viewed by clicking the "Response" link. If you are unsure about the reason for the rejection, please contact the HelpDesk. If the rejected message includes at least one Declaration item with a warning, the message is marked as "Rejected with Warning."

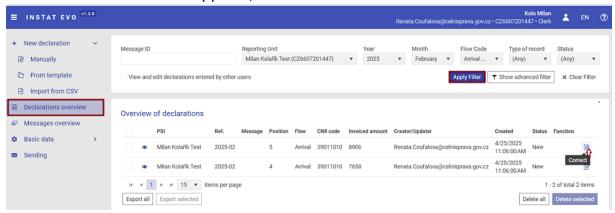
Error

A Declaration enters the error status due to a technical issue and is highlighted in orange. If this status occurs, always contact the HelpDesk.

10 Corrections of Declaration Items

10.1 Unsubmitted Declaration Items

In the Declaration Items Overview, locate the items you wish to correct. Click on **Edit** and make the necessary changes. After editing, click **Save Declaration Item**. In the confirmation window that appears, click **OK**.

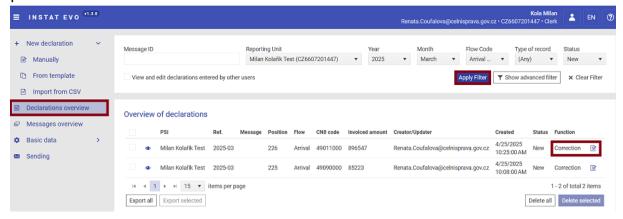


10.2 Submitted Declaration Items

In the Declaration Items Overview, locate the items you want to correct. Click on **Edit** and update the data. After making the changes, click **Save Declaration Item**. In the confirmation window that appears, click **OK**. The original Declaration item will no lonnger appear in the overview; a new item will be displayed with the function **Correct**.



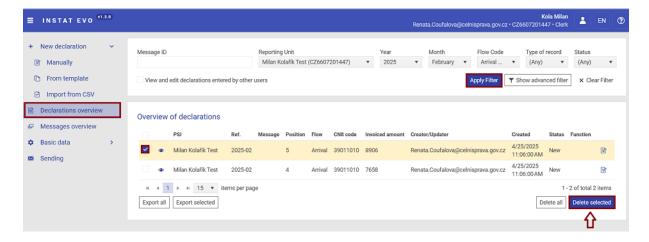
The new Declaration item marked as a **Correction** must be submitted according to the procedure described in section 6.



11 Deleting Declaration Items

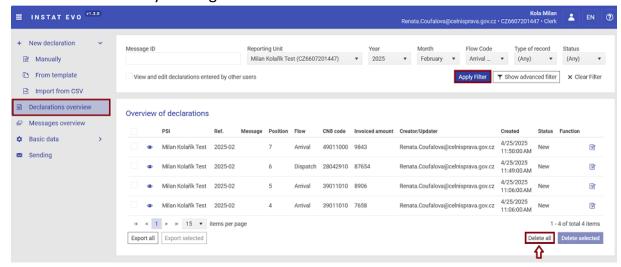
8. 1. Unsubmitted Declaration Items

In the Declaration Items Overview, locate the items you wish to delete. Select the Declaration item you need to remove by clicking the checkbox on the left side of the respective row. Click the **Delete Selected** button. In the confirmation dialog that appears, click **YES**. The Declaration item will be deleted—confirm the action by clicking **OK**.



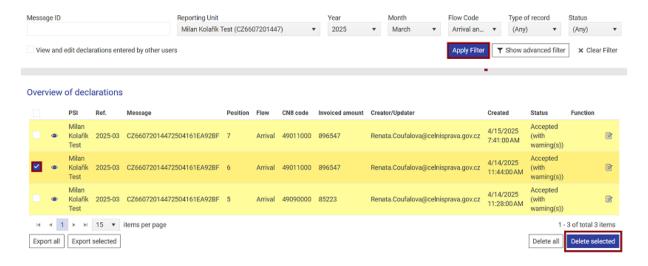
Alternatively, you can filter the Declaration items and use the **Delete All** function. This option is recommended when deleting large volumes of Declaration items. Filter the items you wish to delete according to section 5.4. By clicking the **Delete All** button, all Declaration items that match the filter criteria across all pages will be deleted. In the confirmation dialog that appears, click **YES**. The Declaration items will be deleted—

confirm the action by clicking **OK**.



8. 2 Submitted Declaration Items

In the Declaration Item Overview, locate the declaration items you wish to delete. Select the declaration to be deleted by clicking the checkbox to the left of the item in the corresponding row. Click the "Delete selected" button. In the confirmation dialog, click the "YES" button. The declaration item will be deleted—confirm by clicking "OK." The original declaration will no longer appear in the Declaration Item Overview. Instead, a new declaration item with the function type "Deletion" will be displayed. This deletion-type declaration item must be submitted in accordance with section 6.

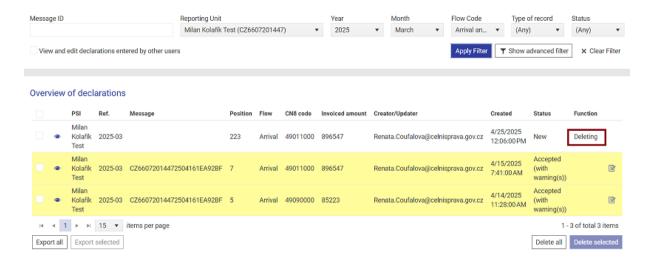


Figure. A new declaration item with the function type "Deletion" must be submitted in accordance with section 6

By filtering and using the "Delete All" button

Use this option when deleting a large number of declaration items. Filter the declaration items you want to delete according to section 5.4. By clicking the "Delete All" button, all declarations that meet the filter criteria and are spread across any number of pages will be deleted. In the confirmation dialog, click the "YES" button. The declaration item will be deleted—confirm with the "OK" button. In the "Declaration item overview", the original declarations will no longer appear; instead, new declarations with the *Deletion* function will be displayed. Deletion declarations must be submitted according to section 6.

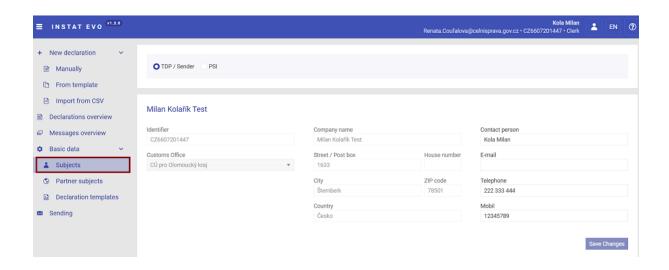
12 Basic data

Master data display information about Representatives/Declarants and Reporting Units as registered with the customs office. These data are not editable in the application, except for contact details such as the contact person's name, phone number (for the declarant), and email. Updating these details ensures quick contact in case of any issues. Changes to other data can only be made using the electronic registration form as described in section 4.

12.1 Subjects

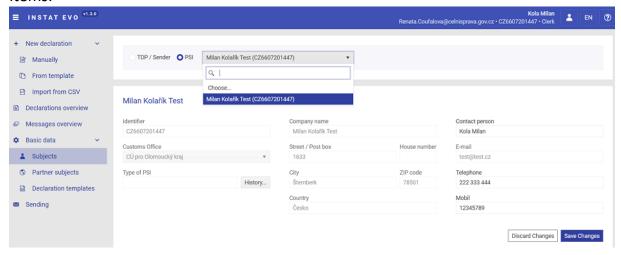
TDP/Sender

In most cases, the Declarant is the same as the Reporting Unit (PSI). However, a representative authorized by the Reporting Unit may prepare and/or submit Intrastat Declarations to the customs office on its behalf.



Reporting Unit (PSI)

Displays all reporting units for which the Declarant/Submitter sends Declaration items.



12.2 Partner subjects.

After pressing the "Add" button, you can enter a VAT identification number or a similar number used for VAT purposes assigned to a partner entity in a European Union member state. This list can be used when manually entering exported goods.

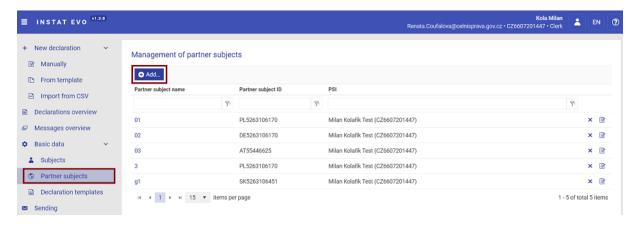


Figure. Form enabling the removal and editing of partner entities.

12.3 Templates of Declaration Items

Templates of declaration items allow you to save frequently used entries with prefilled values (excluding quantity and value data). This feature helps streamline the process of creating new declaration items when similar transactions occur regularly. Templates can be created after entering a new declaration item by clicking the "Save as new template" button **before** saving the declaration item itself.

To use a saved template, go to the "New Declaration Item" menu and select "From Template". Then choose the desired template from the list and click "Select" to load it into the current declaration item form.

Note: Templates are not bound to a specific reference period. Always verify that the saved data complies with the latest legal regulations and coding lists.

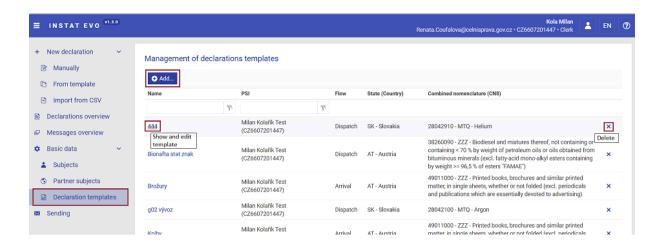


Figure. Form for adding, editing, and deleting a template.
